## Air France Staff Strike May Disrupt Flight Operations on Thursday

Several news sources report that a coordinated strike by 28% of Air France staff may disrupt long-haul flights out of Paris-Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) on Thursday, February 22 as employees join together with trade unions to demand a company-wide pay increase of six percent.

The air carrier [stated today](#) that long-haul flights “will not operate for 24 hours” and “is making every effort to minimize the inconvenience.” There will be fewer disruptions to short and medium-haul flights—overall the strike will affect about [a quarter of all Air France flights](#).

Local sources say [the strike comes after a disagreement](#) between management and workers did not reach a satisfactory compromise.
