

Due to the World Athletic Championship and festivities related to the 70th anniversary of the end of World War II, the Beijing municipal authorities have restricted access to the city between August 20th to September 4th, 2015.



In an effort to ease traffic congestion, the use of trucks will be authorized on alternate days according to the odd/even license plate. While the transportation of all Dangerous Goods, Class 1-9 including 'KEEP COOL'/'PERISHABLE', are prohibited from the Beijing municipal area during this time. Pick-up and delivery may be delayed due to the limited capacity.

At the Beijing Airport, a DG cargo embargo will be in effect on both inbound and outbound shipments from September 1st to September 6th, 2015.

In case DG shipments are accepted at the origin airport and transported to PEK, the shipments may not be delivered due to restrictions placed on the transportation of DG shipments. Additional storage charges may be incurred, as a result. Therefore, we advise all DG shipments to PEK are held until Friday, September 4th, 2015.
