Category 4 Hurricane Matthew Closes Businesses, Ports in Florida

The growing Hurricane Matthew is now classified as a Category 4 hurricane and Floridians are urged to evacuate. The hurricane [has already claimed at least 20 lives](#) while making its way up the Caribbean Sea, through Jamaica, Haiti, and The Bahamas. Approximately 90% of flights at the Miami International Airport are cancelled. Flights to and from [Fort Lauderdale Airport and Orlando Airport are also grounded](#).

Port Everglades and PortMiami traffic [have been suspended since Wednesday](#)—to be closed until Friday. The United States Coast Guard closed Port Canaveral on October 5.
