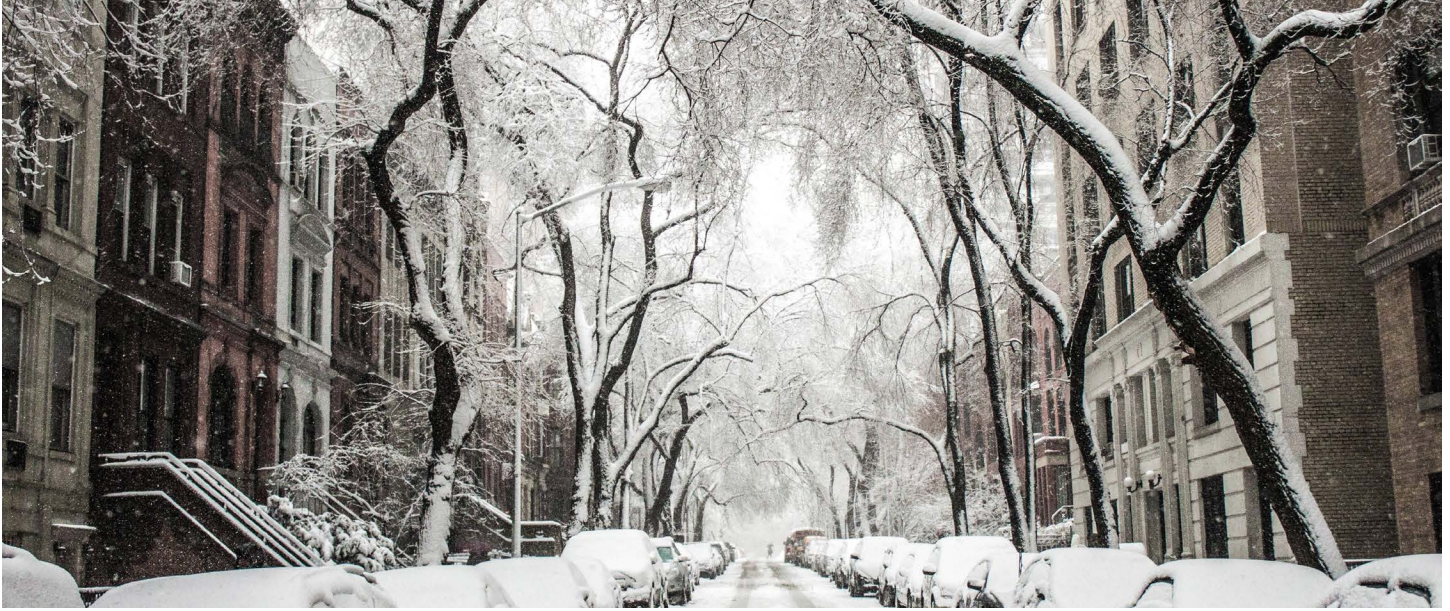

Heavy Snow Forces Grounded Flights and Delays in Northeast Coast

A large blizzard slated to hit the Northeastern corridor on Tuesday, March 14, has led to massive flight cancellations, rail shutdowns, and delays in cargo movement. Winter Storm Stella is expected to bring more than a foot of snow as it blows through parts of [New England and the Northeast megalopolis](#). [Over 6,000 flights](#) across New York, Maryland, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and other states have been canceled in response to warnings of heavy snowfall, with tentative plans to resume Wednesday morning.
