Hurricane Matthew Moves Up Southeast Coast to Georgia, Carolinas

Hurricane Matthew is expected to veer into the Georgia coastline up to South Carolina. Two ports in South Carolina—[Charleston Port](#) and [Georgetown Port](#)—will be closed from October 7 to October 8, and will tentatively reopen on October 10 depending on weather conditions.

The [Georgia Ports Authority](#) has also issued advisories for the closures of Port of Brunswick and Port of Savannah; the ports are expected to resume normal operations on October 10. Operations in Florida ports including Jacksonville and Canaveral are also expected to resume October 10.

Trucking routes, especially on the I-95, have also been heavily impacted following declarations of States of Emergency in the affected areas.
