Raging Fires in California Southland Might Impede Trucking Operations

Insider sources of trucking providers report that the wildfires sweeping Los Angeles and Ventura counties may adversely affect trucking operations in the area due to road closures and sustained traffic congestion. As alternative routings are configured amidst the situation, there is possibility of cancellations and station closures that may delay or even cancel trucking schedules.

The fires, which began Monday, have been exacerbated by high winds and dry winter weather. Efforts to contain the fires have [had little effect in some areas such as Northwestern Los Angeles](#).
