Traffic Disturbances at Gothenburg Airport During Mid-November EU Summit

Due to the European Union summit in Gothenburg, Sweden, significant traffic disturbances are expected at certain times between November 16 and 17.

Local sources report that traffic will be temporarily suspended as the police escort the summit delegates to their accommodations and the summit. While the exact times and itineraries will not be communicated in advance for security reasons, please be advised that the most significant traffic disturbances will occur in the morning and the afternoon of the 17th. As a result, on-time delivery in and out of GOT cannot be guaranteed—the airport will be completely cut off from the road network linking the surrounding areas at the discretion of the Swedish Police. Representatives at KWE Sweden recommend that priority shipments arrive and leave GOT within close of business day, Wednesday November 15. Considerations will be given to avoid and mitigate shipping disturbances for our customers.
