# UPDATE: Blue Cut Fire 22% Contained, Some Rails Reopened

In an update, the Blue Cut fire just north of San Bernardino is now [22% contained according to InciWeb](#), the Incident Information System. Currently, all three BNSF Railway tracks have resumed, with periodic rail inspections. An insider source has also reported that some BNSF trains have also used Union Pacific rails as a detour.

Evacuation notices have been lifted for some residential areas, and the Interstate-15 freeway has been reopened, but there is still considerable caution exercised by residents and emergency personnel. The Blue Cut fire began on Tuesday in the early afternoon and quickly spread throughout parts of San Bernardino and Barstow, growing to nearly 37,000 acres in just three days' time.
