



As the French protests continue, insider sources have determined that while there are no issues for booking or delays in Air Export, truck drivers continue to block roads to some terminals and warehouses, which have impeded sea freight operations. Congestion in ports such as Le Havre and Fos-sur-Mer may adversely impact receipt and transport of cargo. KWE France has reported that export cargo departures may be postponed until next week.

Today, French Prime Minister Manuel Valls asked union leaders to call off protests in the wake of violence between protesters and police, [Reuters reported](#). French President François Hollande has not issued an official statement.
