

In a decision motivated by financial and operational concerns, PMA member ocean carriers and terminal operators will temporarily suspend weekend and holiday vessel operations along the West Coast. As mentioned in a press release by PMA, weekend and holiday pay scales are at least 50 percent above basic longshore wages. Unwilling to pay more for “severely diminished productivity”, PMA concluded with vessel operations suspension taking place on Thursday, February 12th (Lincoln’s Birthday); Saturday, February 14th; Sunday, February 15th; and Monday, February 16th (Washington’s Birthday). Yard, gate and rail operations, however, will continue at terminal operators’ discretion with Southern California terminal operators planning to expand daytime vessel operations on non-holiday weekdays.
