## **Winter Storm Grayson to Stop Port Operations in Southeastern U.S.**

---

**D**ue to forecasted winter storm Grayson taking place in the mid-Atlantic states, terminal operations will be periodically halted starting today at 4:00 AM EST. There will be no truck gate activity and no vessel operations during this time in anticipation of freezing rain and sleet obstructing vision and mobility. Additionally, ports of Norfolk, Virginia and Charleston, South Carolina will be impacted by the storm, potentially resulting in shipment delays.

Winter storm Grayson is expected to travel along the Northeastern coastline, up to Maine by the end of the week, affecting such cities as Baltimore, Washington-Dulles, and Arlington. As such, flights in the Eastern states may be adversely affected by the storm.
