Winter Storms Across Northwest May Delay Rail Shipments

Several sources, including the [National Weather Service](#), have reported heavy snowing, strong winds, and dangerously low temperatures across the Pacific Northwest and Northern regions of America, which may affect railway services throughout the week. Winds blowing at up to 70 mph through Wyoming and Oregon, as well as significant snowfall (over one foot in parts of Idaho) are expected to impact rail delivery times throughout the Pacific Northwest, Los Angeles Basin, and Chicago, with shipment delays lasting up to 72 hours. Snow storms are also predicted to hit the mountainous regions of Northern California and Oregon on Saturday, which may exacerbate conditions. [Weather forecasters predict](#) strong ice storms taking place as early as Tuesday.
